

TTCA 2002-2003 Civil Engineering Award

Trinidad Contractors Limited was awarded the Trinidad and Tobago Contractors Association 2002-2003 Civil Engineering Award. The winning project was the Anti Scour Protection for the Grenada Ports Authority in St. Georges, Grenada.

The Grenada Port had suffered severe scouring of the seabed at the toe of the steel sheet piles caused by the ship's bow thrusters and propellers while docking and undocking at the port. The Port Authority was concerned about the loss of seabed material from the passive side of the sheet piling.

The solution was to install a row of gabion baskets 2m wide x 0.5m deep along the full 336m length of the main berth to a depth of 10m below mean sea level.

The job was completed in the allocated time, without any accident or incident, within budget and to the client's satisfaction.
